Parent's code of conduct

- 1 Parents / spectators must always respect all coaches decisions
- 2 Encourage all the children in the session, not just your own
- 3 Never shout at players or try to give instruction during a training session
- 4 Keep any dispute to yourself until an appropriate time (i.e. – the next training session or private phone call) to respect the coach / team rep
- 5 Parents / spectators must never use foul or abusive language or engage in aggressive behaviour before, during or after a training session and lead by example to uphold the spirit of the game and the good name of the club.
- 6 Failure to adhere to these codes of conduct will result in verbal then written warnings and finally expulsion from the club
