Parent's code of conduct

- Parents / spectators must always respect all managers decisions on match days
- Encourage all the children in the team, not just your own
- Never shout at players or try to give instruction during a game
- Always respect the decision given by the referee
- Keep any dispute to yourself until an appropriate time (i.e. – the next training session or private phone call) to respect the manager / team rep
- Parents / spectators must never use foul or abusive language or engage in aggressive behavior before, during or after a match and lead by example to uphold the spirit of the game and the good name of the club.
- Failure to adhere to these codes of conduct will result in verbal then written warnings and finally expulsion from the club
